

Mexican Issuers Available to Trade in MILA

In accordance to the **Integration Agreements** of the non-fixed income markets subscribed by the BMV, BCS¹, BVC² and BVL³; as well as the Thirteenth Title of BMV's **Rules of Procedures** and subparagraph 1.12 Trading in the Latin American Integrated Market Routing of Orders from a Brokerage Firm through a Local Member (South – North Model) of the **Trading Rules**, the Mexican issuers available for trading through the Latin American Integrated Market (MILA), will be those non-fixed income issuers listed in the Mexican Stock Exchange (BMV) corresponding to:

Listed issuer in the BMV	BCS	BVC	BVL
Local and foreign issuers' listed in the local market	✓	✓	✓
Local Exchange Traded Funds (TRAC'S)	✓	✓	✓
Local Real estate investment trusts (FIBRAS)	✓	-	✓

BMV's Integral Members must identify the buy or sell orders subject to Intermediate Routing from a Foreign Intermediary, at the moment this orders are entered through the Means of Access of the Integrated Market.
